Important to note:

Every person below the age of 18 years is considered a “child”.

The delegates are especially encouraged to consider their personal environment and experiences to find issues and propose solutions! The input to this approach comes from the rights of the child expert Annegret Wigger during preparatory meetings. The Trogen organization fully encourages this approach since it gives a unique possibility to link the YPAC’s Umbrella Topic with the participants.

It might be the case, that some countries do already have specific solutions for issues occurring in other countries. Please do keep this in mind during your committee sessions and strive to learn from each other.

It might also occur during the committee work, that it is not clear whether an issue belongs to one or another committee. In this case, please get in touch with the other committee’s presidents to avoid similar postulations.

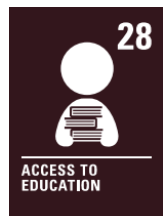
Committee 1: Personal development and Education

- Access to information
- How inclusive and participatory is our school system on every level?
 - Kindergarten
 - Primary school
 - Secondary school
- Is our school system flexible enough to cope with new, unexpected and/or challenging situations?
 - Covid-19
 - Digitalization
- Are the subjects taught still relevant in our days? Should subjects be included or replaced?

What are the challenges that our school systems are facing currently and in the future? Are our school systems prepared to face them? Are the subjects taught still relevant in our days? Should subjects be included or replaced?

How can important topics be made accessible to young children so they can understand them?

How can children of lower social classes be encouraged to go to highschool and university? Is our school system adapted to both boys and girls? How many boys/girls enter secondary school?



Committee 2: Health and well-being

- Equal rights for all children in the healthcare system
- Rights of children in families
 - In case of a divorce
 - In case of conflicts in families
 - Is enough help available for children in such situations?
 - (etc.)
- How can children exercise their right to decide about their own health?
 - In case of a [disease]
 - In case of Covid-19
 - Etc.
- How can the child's opinion be actively considered in the decision making?

In what way should the will of the child be listened to during a divorce (for example concerning child custody)?

How can the same care be ensured for every child independently of its parents wealth? (as an example: braces or glasses)

How can the privacy of children be protected (data, picture & video)?

Who should decide if a child must get vaccinated (the child, parents, politics)?

How can children be protected of violence within the family? How can children be informed about their rights concerning health and well-being?



Committee 3: Freedom of expression / participation

- Participation on all levels of society
 - In politics on national, regional, and communal level
 - In school on secondary, primary, and kindergarten level
- Participation in the institutional response to Covid-19
 - Mainly concerning school level
- Respecting the opinions of minors and giving them a chance to speak
- In what way does our society, family or the media influence the children's freedom of expression or participation? Should there be changes?
- Parent/child relation:
 - To which extent can parents decide for their child?
 - To which extent can children decide on their own?

What measures can be taken to give children a say? Do children have the necessary platforms to share their thoughts and ideas? What should politicians do to listen to and take into account the children's words/opinions especially since they are not able to vote yet? How can children's ideas and visions be included into our society, also concerning young children?

How can children be included in decision-making at school (by the school board for example)?



Committee 4: Equality / integration / migration

- Freedom of religion
- Education and integration of children with a migration background
- Gender and homosexuality
- Equality and integration of children with disabilities

What measures can be taken to integrate children with a migration background into society? How can children with a migration background be given access to social activities? How can contacts with native peers be facilitated? How can they be supported in learning the country's language?

What measures can be taken to enable children with disabilities (for example Children in wheelchairs, children with AD/HD, children with Trisomia 21, blind/deaf children, etc.) to attend the school they want to go to?

How can any kind of barrier preventing children with disabilities to participate fully in society be removed?

Can gender or sexual orientation be a barrier for certain career? How can this be changed? How can freedom of religion be guaranteed at school? Should religion classes be taught at school, and if so, what religion should they include/focus on?

The role of the Press group

This year's YPAC is different than it has ever been. The Youth Parliament to the Alpine Convention 2021 is carried out virtually via zoom. Additionally, there are also several adaptations concerning the press group. All media is published on both Instagram and the website ypac.eu.

What we in Trogen expect from you are the following documents:

- By Monday, 22. March 2021, 5:00 pm, you ought to send in a short video presenting your delegation. You, as the press group member of your school, should record a video of about 1 minute in which you tell from which country, region and school you're from and how many students your delegation consists of. In addition, it would be great if you talked about a special feature of your region and show a typical item.
- Plus, we want a five-second video of each of the members of the delegation waving at the camera.
- You can hand in these elements as raw files, so you don't have to cut anything.
- Each day, we would like to receive a summary and a short clip of what has been discussed in the committee during the meetings of that day. So that we in Trogen have enough time to process your submitted files, we would like you to send them in by 5:30 pm. This should be handed in as a raw file of about 1 minute as well, **together** with a text (max. half a A4 page). Please refer to the attached list of the press group members.
- The videos can be filmed with the selfie camera of your cell phone, so that it is applicable for social media (format 1:1, square). Please consider that the material can be cropped (do not film too close to your face!).
